► A Saturday evening **Potluck Barbecue** will take place in the Park for CYA'ers and guests. Bring your own table service and something for your crowd to barbecue. Also bring something to share: a side dish or dessert for 10 to 20 people.

► **Sunday is the big day.** Put up the party flags and don period attire (optional). Our classics will be open to the public from 1000 to 1500 hours.

► Write a check for \$30.00 payable to CYA-Southern Fleet. This is to pay for the plaques and insurance. Mail it to Jim Butz or bring it with you.

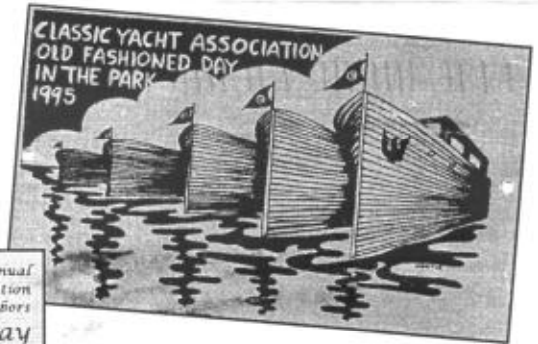
